### Instrument information

Violins and violas must rent their instruments and bring them to class each time.

Cello must rent their own instrument for at home and may bring their instruments to school for every class.

The school owns a few instruments at the smaller sizes and can be used when forgetting or for cello instead of bringing it back and forth.

## Renting:

House of Note is a strings only store. This means they are the best in both quality and service. 7202 Minnetonka Blvd. (952) 929-0026

Remember to tell them you are Providence to get a special introductory rate.

Other stores: Schmitt Music, Groth Music and others. You may find the rental agreement about the same from all stores.

Basically you rent to buy. Your rental dollars goes towards the purchase. Students move through the different sizes as they grow and the rental money follows until 80% purchased which is equal to the trade in value.

Care and maintenance:

Parents must be present when showing to friends.

Do not keep the instrument in a very cold place or they may crack,. or a very warm place as the varnish and glue can become soft. Do not transport it in the trunk or leave it in the car when shopping etc.

If the strings become extremely loose the bridge may fall and/or the sound post may fall. This is fixable - don't panic. Dropping it can do the same thing.
